

MANAGE-IVRI Collaborative training programme on “Organic Animal Husbandry” concluded



A training programme on “**Organic Animal Husbandry** was organized at the Division of Extension Education, ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar” in collaboration with MANAGE, Hyderabad during 24 - 31 October, 2018.
