A one-day training on 'Hygienic abattoir practices' was conducted by ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar at Marya Frozen Agro foods Products Pvt. Ltd., Bareilly, under the aegis of an ICAR-NIAP network project 'Policy imperatives for developing value chain in agricultural commodities in India' on 27th September, 2018. The project is in operation in Division of Livestock Economics, Statistics and Information Technology under the supervision of Dr. D. Bardhan, Principal Scientist. Scientists from Division of Livestock Products Technology, viz. Dr. S.K. Mendiratta, Pr. Scientist & Head, Dr. Suman Talukdar, Scientist and CC-COPI in the project, Dr. Rajeev Ranjan, Sr. Scientist and Dr. Sagar Chand, Scientist, imparted the training programmes.
