

Government of India-IVF training programme (18th December to 7th January, 2018) at ICAR-IVRI

Twenty-one days GOI-IVF hands on training has started from 18 December 2017 at ICAR-IVRI, in the Division of Physiology & Climatology. Three participants working as Veterinary Officers in the state animal husbandry departments of Punjab & Uttarkhand are participating in the above mentioned training. This second batch of training is being imparted under the directives of Government of India, coordinated by DADF; earlier first batch took training on IVF w.e.f. 13th November to 3rd December, 2017. The very aim of these trainings are to strengthen the Veterinary Officers with *In Vitro Fertilization* (IVF), strictly in the hands on mode, so as to use this ART tool for the faster propagation of valuable indigenous germplasm of Livestock and endangered species. Bag, Principal Scientist, P&C Division is imparting this GOI-IVF training under the supervision of Head P&C Division and monitoring of Joint Director (Research) with the directives of Director ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar.
