

GOI-IVF Training sponsored by DAHDF concluded today

A 21 day's training programme sponsored by the DAHDF, Government of India, for Veterinary officers was organized by the Division of Physiology & Climatology, ICAR- IVRI, Izatnagar on ***In vitro* fertilization technique (IVF)** during 18.12.2017 to 07.01.2018. The training programme which was conducted by Dr. Dr Sadhan Bag, Principal Scientist under the supervision of Head, P&C Division and guidance from Joint Director (Research) and honorable Director, ICAR-IVRI concluded today.
