

**TEC, ICAR – IVRI, Pune organised Animal Health Camp at Shevkhandi village, Nashik
and monitored progress of TSP Programme at Gawandh village, Nashik**

Training and Education Centre (TEC) of ICAR – IVRI, Pune in collaboration with State Animal Husbandry Department, Government of Maharashtra organised animal health camp on 24th July 2018 at Shevkhandi tribal village of Peint taluka in Nashik district. A total of 118 animals comprising cattle (69), buffalo (32) and goat (17) of 26 farmers were treated for worm infestation (85), ectoparasitic infection (11), deficiency disorders (21) and skin allergy (1). Dr SK Das and Dr HP Aithal, Principal Scientists of TEC, IVRI, Pune and Dr Santosh Shinde, Livestock Development Officer of State Animal Husbandry Department have participated in the animal health camp.

In addition to the animal health camp, monitoring of goat units distributed to 20 farmers under TSP programme was done on 23rd July 2018 at Gawandh tribal village of Peint taluka in Nashik district. Body weight of new born kids was recorded, health condition of animals was checked and sick animals were treated. Further, interaction with farmers was done to ensure proper housing, feeding and management of goats. Mineral and vitamin mixture was distributed to each farmer.
