

Kaveri Chicks Distribution among the Rural Women in Hanskhali Block of West Bengal under Development Action Plan for Scheduled Castes

The ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI), Eastern Regional Station (ERS), Kolkata organized an “Input Distribution Program” in Muragachha village (Hanskhali) in Nadia district on



24th January, 2024. Two hundred (n=200) women belonging to scheduled caste community joined in the programme to receive the Kaveri chicks. All the beneficiaries underwent a poultry health awareness training program either on 11th or 19th of January, 2024. Dr. G. K. Das and Dr, A. K. Das, Principal Scientists from ICAR-IVRI-ERS, Kolkata was present in the occasion. Four thousand (n=4000) chicks and 200 medicine kits containing a



combination of multi-vitamins, liver extracts, immune-modulators, anthelmintic, liquid calcium,



electrolytes were distributed among the beneficiaries along with a instruction sheet stating the proper



use of the supplements and the medicines.
