

Awareness Programme on Balanced Fertilizer Application and Integrated Nutrient Management (INM) Conducted under MGMG Programme

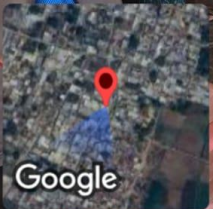
An awareness programme on “Balanced Fertilizer Application and Integrated Nutrient Management (INM)” was successfully organized under the MGMG Programme on 19 May 2026 at Bija Mau village. The programme was conducted by Team 20 with the active participation of 24 farmers, including 17 male and 7 female farmers.

The programme aimed to create awareness among farmers regarding the importance of balanced use of fertilizers, soil health management, and the adoption of Integrated Nutrient Management practices for sustainable agriculture. During the interaction, farmers were informed about the judicious use of chemical fertilizers along with organic manures, crop residues, biofertilizers, and micronutrients to improve soil fertility and crop productivity while reducing environmental degradation.

The team members, including Dr. Rajveer Singh Pawaiya, Dr. Sunil E.
