

Organized skill training for progressive farmers under NEH flagship programme

December 11, 2023: A skill training was organized jointly by ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute and ICAR-KVK Goalpara, National Research Centre on Pig at Daranggiri village, Assam during 04-06 December, 2023. The skill training entitled ‘**pig production and health management in context to climate change**’ was conducted to improve knowledge and skill of pig raisers in area of scientific pig production and health care. In this programme, 6 different aspects like climate smart breed, housing, feeding practice, major diseases and their management, national control animal disease programme and marketing were covered. In addition, practical on preparation of disinfection solution, pig shed disinfection and identification of healthy and illing animals. Total 30 farmers and farm women participated from the village and adjoining villages in these three days training programme. The training organizer also emphasized the role of farmers in Classical Swine Fever Control Programme (CSF-CP) under Livestock Health and Disease Control Scheme. An interactive session was also conducted and various issues like farm biosecurity measures for African swine fever, farm insurance, bank loan, piglet mortality, and abortion were addressed.
