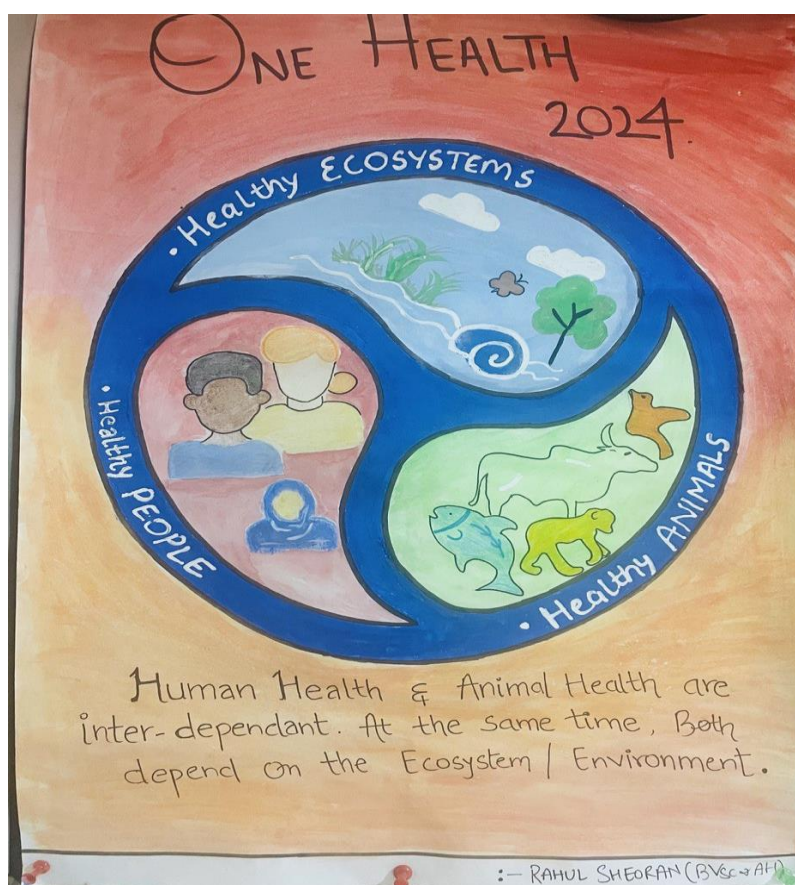


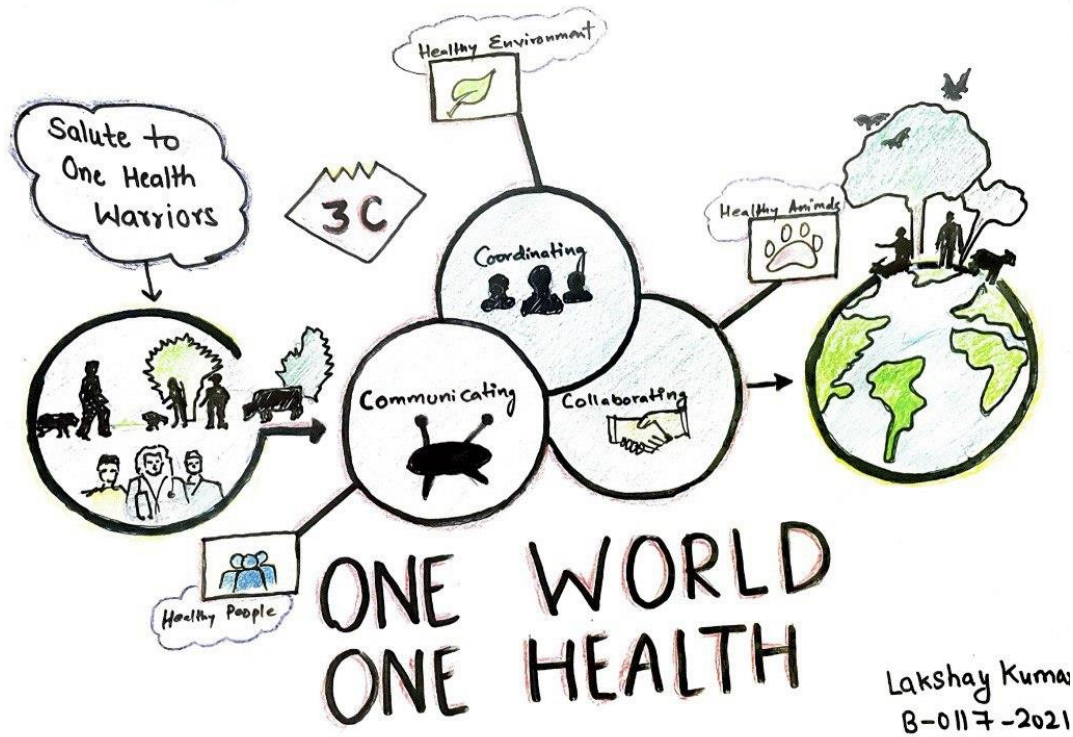
Celebration of One Health Day-2024

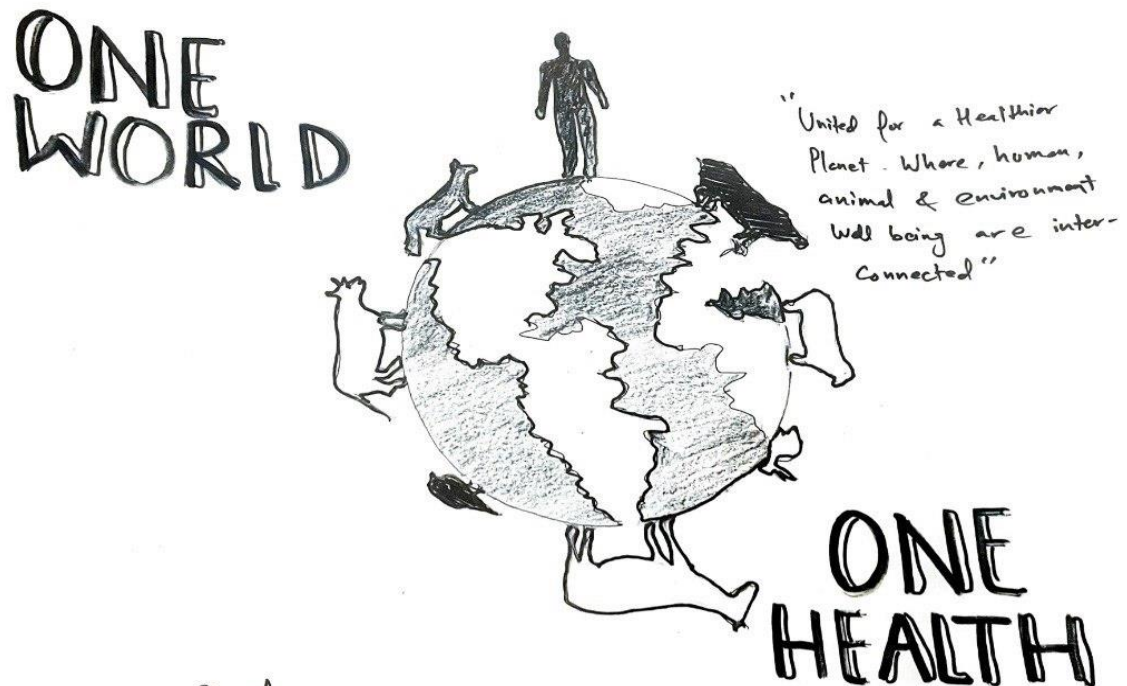
