The Biological Products Division of ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute organised an SCSP (Scheduled Caste Sub Plan) Input Distribution Programme under the aegis of the Joint Directorate of Extension Education on 27 February 2026 at the Committee Room of the Extension Education Division.
