Inauguration of the One-week training program on “Veterinary vaccines and vaccination: Principles and practices under field conditions”

The ICAR - Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI), Hebbal campus, Bengaluru, Karnataka, is conducting a one-week training program on “Veterinary Vaccines and Vaccination: Principles and Practices Under Field Conditions” from 05-11, March 2025. On the occasion of inaugural on 05 March, Dr. B.R. Gulati, Director, ICAR – NIVEDI, adorned the dias as chief guest and emphasized that the training program is timely and well-designed to meet the needs of practicing veterinary officers in field conditions.
