

Inauguration of ICAR Winter School at ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar on 24.1.2024

A 21-day Winter School on “Development and translation of new generation vaccines and diagnostics for animal health from lab to land” sponsored by the Education Division of ICAR is being organized at the Division of Veterinary Biotechnology, ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar during 24.1.24 – 13.2.24. The inaugural function of the Winter School was graced by Dr. Triveni Dutt, Director cum Vice Chancellor, ICAR-IVRI, Dr. K.P. Singh, Joint Director (CADRAD), Dr. S.K. Mendiratta, Joint Director (Academic), Dr. Rupasi Tiwari, Joint Director (Extension Education) of ICAR – IVRI, Izatnagar. The training programme has been specifically designed to cater to the needs of the participants to hone their skills in cutting edge frontier research and further means to translate them into viable technologies. A total of 20 participants at the level of Scientists of ICAR/ Assistant Professor of SAUs drawn from various parts of the country are attending the training programme.



Dr. Triveni Dutt in his presidential address described the genesis of the institute and dwelled upon the various research achievements and the IP and technology portfolio of the Institute. He emphasized upon the role of human resource development in developing one’s career. Dr. K.P. Singh described about the genetic engineering tools available in generating the newer diagnostics and vaccines for animal health. Dr. S.K.
