

TEC-IVRI Pune organised a training on “Goat Farming for Livelihood Improvement” on 16th March 2023 at Taleghar village of Ambegaon taluka in Pune district (Maharashtra) under SCSP programme

TEC, ICAR-IVRI, Pune in collaboration with Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Maharashtra organised a training programme on “Goat Farming for Livelihood Improvement” for farmers under SCSP programme at Taleghar village of Ambegaon taluka in Pune district on 16th March 2023. A total of 140 farmers including 53 women of 11 different villages of Ambegaon taluka (Taleghar, Gabhori, Pimpri, Rajpur, Megholi, Patwa, Bhimgaon, Nigdale, Piyali, Terugaon, Jamori) participated in the training.

At the outset, the *Sabapati*, Ambegaon Panchayat Samiti, Taleghar, welcomed the scientists of IVRI and officers of State Animal Husbandry Department and the participants. In his address, *Sabapati* appreciated the efforts made by IVRI and State Department of Animal Husbandry for organising the training programme as well as the farmers for actively participating in the training. Dr SK Das, Principal Scientist, TEC, Pune in his address told about the different activities of the Center, achievements under SCSP programme, and prospects of goat farming for livelihood improvement of resource poor farmers. Dr Amol Bhalerao, Scientist, TEC, Pune gave a lecture on “*Entrepreneurship development through goat husbandry*”. Three experts from Department of Animal Husbandry delivered lectures on different aspects of goat farming in local Marathi language. Dr Suresh D Kad (LDO, Valeti) delivered a lecture on “*Housing management, breeds and breeding system of goats*”; Dr VD Yewale (LDO, Avasan) talked about “*Feeds and fodder availability and feeding management of goats*”; and Dr YS Raghatwan (LDO, Taleghar) delivered a lecture on “*Disease incidence and health management of goats*”. Afterwards the participants actively participated in interaction and discussion, expressing their own experiences, success stories and problems faced by them. At the end, certificates were distributed to all the participants.
