**NOTIFICATION**

On the recommendations of the Virtual Meeting of the Grievance Committee held on 16.07.2020 at 11.30 AM, the Competent Authority has been pleased to notify the below mentioned decision (s) for implementation and necessary action: -

**A. Extraordinary measures to be undertaken for in-service candidates:**

1. The in-service students who are at their native places, may be allowed to join their organizations and may continue their remaining research work at their organization or at nearby laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/ SVU in consultation with Chairperson, BOS and SAC. While doing so, it may be ensured that the overall quality of the experiment may not be deteriorated. The permission in this respect is mandatory from IVRI Deemed University. After permission of Competent Authority, such students will be allowed to start their remaining research work at their place of posting or nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/SVU by including the name of one faculty in the SAC for local supervision as SAC member, with clear cut condition that he will submit the monthly progress report of the student by every 3<sup>rd</sup> day of the month regularly on thesis research work through his Advisor & concerned Head of Division, IVRI Deemed University.
2. The in-service students, who are at remote location or at disadvantageous area, where working at nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/SVU is not possible/ feasible, they may be allowed temporary dropping on their request as one time relaxation and intimation in this regard may be sent to their respective Institute/ University with the request to allow them to rejoin the programme when the situation becomes normal following the guidelines/advisories in this regard issued from Deemed University from time to time.

**B. Extraordinary measures to be undertaken for students who have rejoined the Deemed University after temporary dropping:**

1. They may be allowed to join their respective Organization and continue their research work at their place of posting or nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/ SVU, provided these organizations have required infrastructure to carry out the remaining research work, in consultation with Chairperson, SAC & BOS. While doing so, it may be ensured that the overall quality of the experiment may not be deteriorated. The permission in this respect is mandatory from IVRI Deemed University. After permission of Competent Authority, such students will be allowed to start their remaining research work at their place of posting or nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/ SVU by including the name of one faculty in the SAC for local supervision as SAC member, with clear cut condition that he will submit the monthly progress report of the student by every 3<sup>rd</sup> day of the month regularly on thesis research work through his Advisor & concerned Head of Division, IVRI Deemed University.
2. Students whose place of posting is at remote location or at disadvantageous area, where working at the place of posting or nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/ SVU is not

possible/feasible, they may be allowed to join their organizations after permitting them second temporary dropping as one time relaxation with the condition that their parent organization will allow them to rejoin the programme when the situation becomes normal. The maximum period for completion of degree programme in respect of the students who were sanctioned temporary dropping is seven years in case PhD and five in case of MVSc which may be further extended as per UGC guidelines and ICAR Advisories.

**C. Extraordinary measures to be undertaken for students who are on temporary dropping and wants to rejoin the Deemed University for submission of online pre-thesis seminar and thesis submission & completion of remaining research work:**

1. They may be allowed to re-join online at the Deemed University after taking due permission from their Department/ University to complete the remaining online thesis submission work.
2. If the sanctioned period of temporary dropping of the students is over and they want to re-join the Deemed University to carry out remaining research work, they may be allowed to continue their research work at their respective place of posting or nearby organization or nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/SVU, provided; these organizations have required infrastructure to carry out the remaining research work in consultation of Chairperson, SAC & BOS. While doing so, it may be ensured that the overall quality of the experiment may not be deteriorated. The permission in this respect is mandatory from IVRI Deemed University.

**Resolution:**

After detailed deliberation on the proposed agenda, “A”, “B” & “C” above have been agreed in principle, with the suggestion in first instance, that Deemed University makes a list of such in-service students (proposed at Point No.1 of Agenda ‘A’ and ‘B’ above), who have submitted their ORW, they may be **allowed to carry out remaining research work at their place of posting or at nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/SVU on the recommendations of the SAC & Chairman, BOS.**

In addition, the Chairman suggested that a letter shall be issued to the advisors to instruct their students who have not submitted their ORW, **they may prepare ORW with the technical program keeping in view the infrastructure/laboratory available at their place of posting or at nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/SVU where the work can be carried-out.**

While doing so, it may be ensured that the overall quality of the experiment may not be deteriorated. The permission in this respect is mandatory from IVRI Deemed University. After permission of Competent Authority, such students will be allowed to start their remaining research work at their place of posting or nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/SVU by including the name of one faculty in the SAC for local supervision as SAC member, with clear cut condition that he will submit the monthly progress report of the student by every 3<sup>rd</sup> day of the month regularly on thesis research work through his Advisor & concerned Head of Division, IVRI Deemed University.

As per point No. 2 of the above agenda “A” & “B”, all such students, who are not in position to continue their research work at their place of posting or at nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/SVU, **shall be allowed temporary dropping (for in-service and second temporary dropping for students who have re-joined after 1<sup>st</sup> temporary dropping) on their request as one time relaxation** during this pandemic situation and an intimation in this regard be sent to their respective Department to allow them to re-join the Deemed University to complete the programme

when the situation becomes normal following the guidelines/advisories issued by the Deemed University from time to time.

Point No. 1 of Agenda “C” above is agreed and it is suggested that all such students who are on temporary dropping and wants to re-join the Deemed University, **shall be allowed to re-join the Deemed University online like other students after taking due permission from their place of posting/University to complete the thesis submission as per the SOP for online thesis submission and evaluation developed by the Deemed University.**

As regards, the Point No. 2 of Agenda “C” above is concerned; the same is agreed in principle with the suggestion in first instance, that Deemed University makes a list of such students, who are on temporary dropping and have submitted their ORW **shall be allowed to carry out remaining research work at their place of posting or at nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/SVU on the recommendations of the SAC & Chairman, BOS.**

In addition, the Chairman suggested that a letter shall be issued to the advisors to instruct their students who have not submitted their ORW, **they may prepare ORW with the technical program keeping in view the infrastructure/laboratory available at their place of posting or at nearby laboratory/ institute/ SAU/SVU where the work can be carried-out.**

While doing so, it may be ensured that the overall quality of the experiment may not be deteriorated. The permission in this respect is mandatory from IVRI Deemed University. After permission of Competent Authority, such students will be allowed to start their remaining research work at their place of posting or nearby Laboratory/ Institute/ SAU/SVU by including the name of one faculty in the SAC for local supervision as SAC member, with clear cut condition that he will submit the monthly progress report of the student by every 3<sup>rd</sup> day of the month regularly on thesis research work through his Advisor & concerned Head of Division, IVRI Deemed University.
