# **DETAILED PROCEDURE FOR USING THE IVRI BVSc & AH ADMISSION 2023-24 APPLICATION PORTAL**

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## 1. ABOUT ICAR-INDIAN VETERINARY RESEARCH INSTITUTE

Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI) was established on 9<sup>th</sup> December, 1889 as Imperial Bacteriological Laboratory at Pune (Maharashtra) and was shifted to Mukteswar, Distt. Nainital (Uttarakhand) in 1893. Subsequently, for extending the activities of the Institute; Izatnagar, Bareilly (UP) campus was established in 1913 for large-scale production of serum and vaccines. It gradually expanded to the present size with its headquarters at Izatnagar (UP) and campuses at Mukteswar, Distt. Nainital (Uttarakhand), Bengaluru (Karnataka) and regional stations at Palampur (HP), Kolkata (West Bengal) and Pune (Maharashtra). The administrative control of the Institute is vested with the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR).

The research contributions of the Institute have facilitated development of new biologicals including diagnostics, vaccines and technologies for diagnosis, prevention, cure and control of many devastating diseases of livestock and poultry, increased production of milk, meat, eggs and other animal products. Improvement of livestock and poultry with increased production potential, overcoming the shortage of animal feeds by better utilization of existing feed resources and substitution of conventional feeds by cheaper agro-industrial byproducts are other significant contributions.

Post-graduate teaching and training programmes started in 1900 at the Institute when training was imparted to field veterinarians, civil and army personnel on various aspects of animal healthcare. Later, Associate-ship and National Diploma courses were added as part of post graduate teaching programme. However, with the establishment of Post-Graduate College of Animal Sciences in 1958, the institute started conferring degree in Veterinary and Animal Sciences. The Institute has been conferred the status of Deemed to be University with effect from 16<sup>th</sup> November, 1983 under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act (1956). The first academic session of the Deemed University started on 15<sup>th</sup> January, 1985. From the academic session 2015-16, the institute has initiated under-graduate programme in Veterinary Sciences (BVSc & AH degree). Besides, imparting undergraduate education leading to BVSc & AH degree, the institute is also providing quality education at masters' and doctorate levels in 19 and 17 disciplines, respectively.

The Institute has been attracting a large number of foreign students, especially from developing countries. Scholars have also been deputed to this Institute from different countries for various short-term and long-term training programmes, diplomas and degree programmes. Besides the above courses, the institute has also been conducting various short-term National and International Training Programmes, Short Courses and Summer Institutes from time to time to make the professionals familiar with latest developments in Veterinary and Animal Sciences. The Institute has also been recognized as the Centre for Advanced Faculty Training in Animal Nutrition and Animal Physiology by ICAR, New Delhi.

The Institute, spread over an area of 440.54 Acres, has a well established National Library of Veterinary Sciences, ARIS Cell (computer centre), Communication centre, Student Welfare Section, Medical dispensary, Referral Veterinary Polyclinic -cum- Teaching Veterinary Clinical Complex, Livestock farms, Feed and Fodder Farms, Boys' and Girls' Hostels, Bank and Post Office facilities at its Izatnagar campus. It is located at a distance of 258 km from New Delhi, and about 8 km from Bareilly Jn. and 1 km from Izatnagar Railway Station.

## 3. INTAKE CAPACITY FOR B.V.Sc. & A.H. DEGREE PROGRAMME

### 3.1. DURATION OF COURSE

The duration of B.V.Sc. & A.H degree course is spread over **five and half complete professional years** including a compulsory rotating **internship of one year duration**.

### 3.3. RESERVATION OF SEATS (to be filled by ICAR-IVRI Deemed University)

#### 3.3.1. Regular/ Open Seats

- (a) 15% seats are reserved for SC candidates,
- (b) 7.5% seats are reserved for ST candidates,
- (c) 27% seats are reserved for non-creamy layer OBC candidates as per Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 10.04.2008 and according to detailed instructions of the Ministry of Human Resource Development issued vide their O.M. No. 1-1/ 2005-UIA/847 dated 20.4.2008. Reservation would be applicable to the castes mentioned in the Central list of OBC. Thus, the candidates falling in this list may mention OBC in the Category Column in application form. **Candidates from creamy layer and those who do not come under Central List of OBC are advised to mention the category as General.**
- (d) 10% seats are reserved for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) of General Category
- (e) 5% seats\*\*\* are reserved on Horizontal basis for Divyang Category (Physically handicapped) candidates as per Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and as defined in MSVE (BVSc & AH) regulations-2016 & under Section 4.1.1(d) of this information bulletin.  
(\*\*\*Horizontal reservation to be given for Divyang Category (PH) candidates as per their merit against the category i.e. General/ OBC/SC/ST to which they belong).

#### 3.3.2. Payment Seats

- (a) Scheduled Cast: 01 seat
- (b) Scheduled Tribe: 01 seat
- (c) Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer): 02 seats

**Note:**

- If the payment seats of reservation category (SC, ST, OBC) are vacant at the end of counseling, these will be filled from the unreserved category candidates.

#### 3.3.3. NRI/ OCI Seats

There will be no seat reservation under this category.

#### 3.3.4. Under VCI Seats

- These seats will be filled-up by Veterinary Council of India as per seat roaster decided by them.

## 4. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO B.V.Sc. & A.H. DEGREE PROGRAMME

### 4.1. ELIGIBILITY

Merit list of NEET(UG) 2023 conducted by National Testing Agency, New Delhi will be used for admissions in BVSc & AH degree programme during 2023-24. In addition to this, the candidate has to satisfy eligibility criteria as per VCI–MSVE Regulations, 2016.

#### 4.1.1. For Regular/Open and Payment Seats

(a) **Nationality** : The candidate should be an Indian National.

(b) **Age** : The candidate must have attained a minimum age of 17 years on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023.

#### (c) **Essential Qualification:**

- The candidate must have qualified NEET(UG) 2023.
- He or She has passed the qualifying examination as defined under VCI-MSVE Regulations, 2016 with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology and English (as a core course) and obtained marks as specified under regulations (7) or an examination equivalent to intermediate science examination of an Indian University or Board recognized by the Association of Indian Universities taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology including a practical test in each of these subjects and English.
- As per MSVE Regulations, 2016, a candidate under General Category for admission to the BVSc & AH degree course shall have to qualify in each of the subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology, and obtained 50% marks in aggregate of these subjects, at the qualifying examination. In respect of candidates belonging to the SC or ST or other special category of students as specified by the Government from time to time, marks required for admission shall be 47.5%.
- Admission of students to BVSc & AH degree course shall be made on the basis of his or her merit obtained in the Merit of NEET(UG)-2023 subject to fulfillment of the other criteria as laid down above including qualifying examination and no other merit or weightage shall be considered.
- **Candidates securing equal to or more than the NEET (UG)- 2023 cut-off marks as per category, will only be considered for admission against Regular/Open or Payment Seats.**

#### (d) **Physical Disability**

A candidate will not be allowed admission to BVSc & AH degree course if he or she suffers the following disabilities, namely:-

- (a) Disability of total body (including chest or spine) more than 50%,
- (b) Disability of lower limb of more than 50%,
- (c) Disability of upper limb,
- (d) Visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability,
- (e) Candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- (f) Disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of the duties of a veterinarian.

**Note:** The disability shall be certified by a duly constituted and Government authorized Medical Board comprising of at least three specialists out of which two shall be of the specialty concerned and the candidate has to present him or her-self before the Medical Board and the last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board shall not be more than three months old from the date of submitting his or her certificate for disabled candidates.

#### 4.1.2. For NRI/ OCI seats\*

- The NRI/OCI and their children/wards only will be considered for admission under this category.
- The candidates seeking admission on the basis of NRI status are required to produce duly attested and verified photocopies of NRI/citizenship certificate, eligibility document and passport or any other valid document.
- The admission will be made on merit of 10+2 examination or equivalent without requirement of appearing in the NEET (UG)-2023.
- The candidate must have attained minimum age of 17 years on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023.
- Candidate must have completed 12 years' school system with Physics, Chemistry, Biology /Biotechnology and English as the core subjects, which is equivalent to 10+2 of Indian School Education. He/ She must have studied in English medium or should submit documentary evidence of proficiency in English language.
- As per MSVE Regulations, 2016, a candidate under General Category for admission to the BVSc & AH degree course shall have to qualify in each of the subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology, and obtained 50% marks in aggregate of these subjects, at the qualifying examination. In respect of candidates belonging to the SC or ST or other special category of students as specified by the Government from time to time, marks required for admission shall be 47.5%.
- Candidates applying under the NRI/OCI category are required to submit a copy of their certificate/ transcript/ marks sheet indicating grades and percentage of marks, duly verified and certified by the Indian Embassy/High Commission in that Country, stating that such examination is equivalent to the qualifying examination (10+2) of Indian Boards/ Universities.
- The syllabi of the courses studied at 10+2 level along-with website address of the institute/school should also be provided with the application form. The relevant documents may also be sent to Registrar, ICAR-IVRI Deemed University through email ([registrar.ivri@gmail.com](mailto:registrar.ivri@gmail.com))
- Candidates are also required to obtain the requisite equivalence certificate from Registrar, IVRI Deemed University by paying a non-refundable processing fee of US \$100 or equivalent in Indian Currency, from the bank account of NRI/OCI maintained in India. The decision of ICAR-IVRI Deemed University in respect of equivalence certificate will be final.

## **5. REGISTRATION FOR COUNSELING (FOR ADMISSION TO B.V.Sc. & A.H. DEGREE PROGRAMME)**

### **5.1. Procedure for Online Registration for Counseling**

- The candidate has to apply online by using the **IVRI BVSc & AH Admission 2023-24 Application Portal** available at <http://ivri.nic.in/BVScAdmPortal>.
- The detailed procedure for using the **IVRI BVSc & AH Admission 2023-24 Application Portal** is available at the end of this information bulletin. The candidates are advised to read the procedure carefully before using it.
- The registration fee [Rs.2000/- for General/OBC/EWS candidates and Rs. 1000/- for SC/ST/Divyang (PH) candidates] has to be submitted online using the link provided in the portal itself.
- Once the steps mentioned above are completed, the candidate has to SUBMIT the application form **by clicking the FINISH button**.
- All the candidates must also mail the scanned copy of the documents/ certificates uploaded on the portal along with the Application Summary Page (as a .zip folder/ .rar folder) on email id: [ivribvscadm2023@gmail.com](mailto:ivribvscadm2023@gmail.com) on or before **13<sup>th</sup> August, 2023**.
- The counseling for admission to BVSc & AH degree programme shall be conducted by ICAR-IVRI Deemed University, Izatnagar and the decision of ICAR-IVRI shall be final.

### **5.2. Documents to be Uploaded at the Time of Online Registration for Counseling**

The candidates should upload the following documents at the time of online registration for counseling failing which they shall not be allowed to take part in counseling for admission:

- a. Passport size colour Photograph (same as for Online Application Form in NEET-UG-2023)
- b. Signature of the candidate
- c. Admit Card of NEET-UG-2023 Examination.
- d. Rank Card of NEET-UG-2023 Examination.
- e. Aadhaar Card of the candidate
- f. Any other Identity card (Voter ID Card, Ration Card, Passport etc.)
- g. Date of Birth Certificate (If Secondary School (High School) Examination Certificate does not have the same, then upload Birth Certificate. If Secondary School (High School) Examination Certificate has the same then upload it)
- h. Secondary School (High School) Examination or equivalent Certificate
- i. Secondary School (High School) Examination mark list
- j. Intermediate (10+2) Mark Sheet (Qualifying Examination Mark Sheet)
- k. Intermediate (10+2) Certificate or Provisional Certificate. Provisional Certificate is permissible for those candidates who had passed in the year 2023 only.
- l. Character Certificate from the School or College last attended.

**The candidate should also upload the following certificates, if applicable:**

- SC/ST Certificate as per format given in Annexure-1 issued by the competent authority and should be in English or Hindi. If it is in regional language then it should be translated in English/Hindi and should be attested by Class I Gazetted Officer. Sub-caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
- OBC Certificate as per format given in Annexure-2 should be issued by the Competent Authority and should be in English or Hindi. If it is in regional language then it should be translated in English/Hindi and should be attested by Class I Gazetted Officer. The sub-caste



should tally with the Central List of OBC. OBC Candidates should not belong to Creamy layer and should provide an undertaking in this regard as per format given in Annexure-3.

- Income & Assets Certificate by economically weaker sections (For General Category Candidates only) as per format given in Annexure-4 should be issued by the Competent Authority and should be in English or Hindi.
- Certificate of Locomotor Disability as per Annexure-5. The disability should be certified by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board comprising of at least three specialists out of which two should be of the specialty concerned and the candidate has to present him/her – self before the Medical Board. The last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board should not be more than three months old from the date of submitting his/her certificate for disabled candidates.

## **6. COUNSELING PROCEDURE (FOR ADMISSION TO B.V.Sc. & A.H. DEGREE PROGRAMME)**

### **6.1. Procedure for Counseling**

- i. The counseling for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course on All India basis shall be conducted by ICAR-IVRI as per availability of seats and his/ her rank, subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria as laid down in this Information Bulletin.
- ii. Counseling for admissions to BVSc & AH degree programme at ICAR-IVRI will be held at the following venue:

- iii. Rank list of registered candidates invited for Counseling will be notified on the IVRI website ([www.ivri.nic.in](http://www.ivri.nic.in)) only. No separate intimation will be sent to the candidates.
- iv. Counseling will be held through offline mode only. Physical presence of the candidate is compulsory at the time of counseling and admission.
- v. The eligibility criteria, various documents (in original) etc. of the candidate shall be verified at the time of counseling and the decision of the college in the matter shall be final.
- vi. Besides the photocopies of the documents mentioned under Section 5.2 of this information bulletin, following additional documents are to be submitted by the admitted candidates on the day of counseling:
  - Copy of IVRI Counseling Registration confirmation page.
  - Migration & Transfer Certificate from the school/ board last attended.
  - Gap Affidavit as per the format given in Annexure-6 (if applicable).
  - Medical Certificate as per Annexure-7.
  - Affidavit for non-participation in ragging as per Annexure-8 and 9.
  - Affidavit for Surety Bond for continuation of study as per Annexure-10.
- vii. The selected candidates will have to deposit the Annual Fee and other charges (as per Section 8 of this information bulletin) on the date of counseling itself.
- viii. Admission letter will be issued to the selected candidates after successful completion of all the counseling formalities.
- ix. The guidelines relating to start of academic session, tuition and other fees, deposit and refund of fees, if any, shall be as per rules and regulations of ICAR-IVRI. The candidate has to abide by the rules and regulations of ICAR-IVRI during his/her studies in B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree programme.
- x. The candidates are requested to regularly visit the IVRI website ([www.ivri.nic.in](http://www.ivri.nic.in)) for any updates/notifications and details of counseling procedure.

### **6.2. Impersonation**

The online self-declaration of the candidate and other documents will be verified at the time of counseling and if found to be false at any time, the candidature/ admission of such candidates shall be cancelled and criminal proceedings may be initiated against them as per law by the authorities of ICAR-IVRI.
